

Beginner Beekeeping Courses 2017



The Saskatchewan Beekeepers' Association, the Regina Bee Club, Saskatoon Bee Club and the Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture are pleased to offer the sixth annual **two-day beginner beekeepers courses in the Regina, Saskatoon, and Prince Albert areas**. Come and enjoy this two day course which enables participants to experience both theory and practical field experience. Instructors include members of Saskatchewan Beekeepers' Association, Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture staff, and experienced beekeepers from the Regina Bee Club/Saskatoon Bee Club. All experience levels are welcome!

Workshop lessons include:

- Standard beekeeping equipment
- Honey bee colony assessments
- Basic bee biology
- Seasonal beekeeping responsibilities
- Extracting/ processing honey
- Disease and pest management practices
- *As much bee information as we can teach in two days!*

- Saskatoon -May 6 & 7, 2016 at Lalonde Honey Farms, Clavet (**mail-in registration deadline May 1, 2017**)
- Regina -May 13 & 14, 2016 at St. Joseph's Honey (**mail-in registration deadline May 8, 2017**)
- Prince Albert- May 27 & 28 North of Shellbrook (**mail-in registration deadline May 22, 2017**)

Fee: \$300.00. Includes cost of lunch and snacks both days, and two manuals: "Honey Bee Disease and Pests 3rd Edition" and "Beekeeping in Western Canada". NOTE: Included in the registration fee, with an additional \$35.00 for lunch and snacks, one child under the age of 14 may accompany you to the course.
